

# openCRX Workshop – GUI Customizing

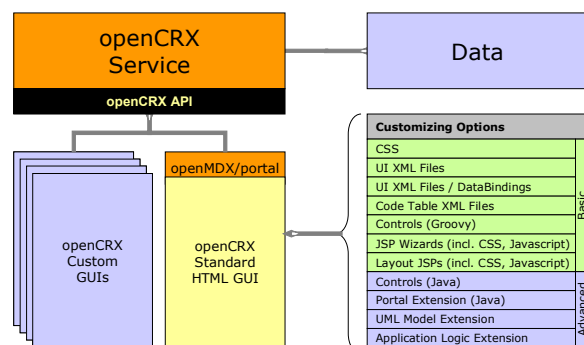

### Prerequisites:

It is recommended that you are familiar with the following concepts/tools if you want to connect with the material taught in the workshop:

- **CSS** – participants should be comfortable with the concepts of cascading style sheets
- **Javascript/Java** – this workshop is neither a Javascript course nor a Java course (i.e. we expect participants to be familiar with these programming languages and their concepts)
- **UML** – it is a good idea to look at the published UML diagrams (<http://www.opencrx.org/>) a few times before you attend this workshop
- **openCRX** – it goes without saying that a certain affinity for openCRX is helpful
